You can officially prove your German language skills with the fide test


The fide test is also recognised by the federal government and cantons as proof of German language skills for residence permits.

What is the fide test?

With the fide test you can prove your oral and written language skills at levels A1 - B1 in the Swiss national languages German, French and Italian! and Italian!

After completing the fide test, participants receive a language passport.

The language passport shows the oral and written levels achieved.

The fide test is the only exam with which you can prove your oral and written skills separately!

You will receive written confirmation of the examination by e-mail approximately 2 weeks before the examination date.

You will receive the examination results directly from fide by mail approx. 4 weeks after the examination date.









There are three types of exam

- 1 fide-Test German (oral + written), CHF 250
- 2 "Speaking & Understanding" (oral only), CHF 170
- 3 "Reading & Writing" (written only), CHF 120

The fide test is suitable for people:

- 1. want to take the partial examinations at different levels (e.g. written A2, oral B1). This is only possible with fide.
- 2. need the exams for the migration authorities.
- 3. for people who are not used to school
- 4. people with a physical impairment (e.g. hearing impairment is taken into account in the exam)
- 5. people with test anxiety it's a much more dynamic exam!

Registration

Registration is binding. The examination fee must be paid at the time of registration. Registration and payment can be made in person at our office at Löwenstrasse 20, 8001 Zurich, or online.

Withdrawal of registration: Withdrawal must be made in writing. Up to 17 days before the exam, you pay a processing fee of CHF 120. If you cancel later, we will charge the entire examination fee.
